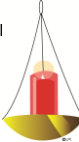

WEEKLY MEDITATION

Let's take a look at some of the main themes we find in the Scripture readings for the Ascension of the Lord.

- 1st Reading - Acts 1:1-11**
- The introduction serves as a bridge between the Gospel of Luke and the Acts of the Apostles (both written by the same author.)
 - The apostles will receive the power of the Holy Spirit and proclaim the Good News to "the ends of the earth."

Psalm 47:2-3,6-7,8-9

- The Church applies this psalm directly to the triumph of Jesus as he ascends to Heaven.
- We rejoice over the victory of our God!

2nd Reading - Option 1 - Ephesians 1:17-23

- A prayer for wisdom and understanding for all disciples.
- Reviews the supremacy of Christ over all things.

2nd Reading - Option 2 - Ephesians 4:1-3

- An invitation to live a life that is worthy of the call that we have received.
- We have received gifts to be shared for the building up of the body of Christ.

Gospel - Mark 16:15-20

- Christ commands his disciples to "go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature."
- The disciples will be filled with power and able to perform many different signs.
- Christ ascends into Heaven; the disciples carry out his mission.

Cathedral School Registration K- 8th Grade

Registration has begun for the 2021-2022 school year. If you or someone you know is interested in enrolling or receiving registration information, please contact the school at 715-392-2976. Some classes fill quickly. Please be sure to register early to guarantee your child's spot.

Cathedral Preschool Registration Is Open!!

Preschool runs five days a week for three hours a day and is a free program. This is an early education option for all families in the Superior School District. Cathedral Preschool's SCP session time runs from 8-11am. Many parents register for both SCP and Cathedral Preschool in order for their children to attend school for a full day. The classes fill on a first come first serve basis. Cathedral Preschool offers a 3-year and 4-year-old program. Cathedral School is also a site for Superior Community Preschool.

Box Tops for Education (Cathedral Home And School Association) participates in several programs, which generate money for our school. Box Tops for Education can be found on several products including food, household items, tableware, office supplies, and even bake ware. **No more clipping.** No more sending Box Tops to school. All you need is your phone. Download the ALL-NEW Box Tops app, shop as you normally would, then simply scan your store receipts to find participating products. Tap the scan button and snap a photo of your receipt within 14 days of purchase. The app will automatically credit your school's Box Tops earnings online. **(Twice a year, your school will receive a check and can use that cash to buy whatever it needs!)**

CALVARY CEMETERY

Flags, flower baskets and other decorations may be placed on graves five (5) days before Memorial Day and **MUST** be removed within fifteen (15) days thereafter. Flowers and other decorations placed in urns or containers built into flush monuments, foot markers or other ground level markers shall be placed and removed in accordance with this same schedule.

Flower baskets, urns and other decorations may be mounted on or attached to monuments. Attachments must be secured to the monument and provide a minimum clearance of 12 inches between the ground and the decoration. Artificial flowers must be secure in their containers.

Flowers and decorations placed for funeral services will be removed by the Sexton when the flowers fade.

The following installations at gravesites **WILL NOT** be allowed:

- Placement of fences, rocks, bricks or other permanent materials around monuments.
- Planting of flowers, trees or other vegetation around monuments or on graves.

Any such installation will be removed by the Sexton without liability.

Memorial trees may be planted at locations approved by the Sexton.

The Association shall not be responsible for theft, vandalism, or accident within the cemetery.

Please Note: *Due to theft and vandalism in previous years, we ask that you **mark your name** (permanently) on flower baskets, urns and other decorations that you place **temporarily** on graves.*

Memorial Day Mass (May 31st) will be celebrated at Calvary Cemetery at 9:00 a.m. (weather permitting). Inclement weather, Mass will be celebrated at Cathedral. Thank you!
