WEEKLY MEDITATION

There are LOTS of options for the Mass Readings for Pentecost, including the Vigil Mass and the Mass During the Day. Here is a short summary:

VIGIL MASS

1st Reading Options

- **Genesis 11:1-9** - The Tower of Babel
- **Exodus 19:3-8,16-20b** - Moses encounters God on Mount Sinai
- **Ezekiel 37:1-14** - Ezekiel prophesizes over the dry bones
- **Joel 3:1-5** - God will pour out the Spirit upon all creation

Psalm Options

- **Psalm 33** - "Blessed the people the Lord has chosen to be his own."
- **Daniel 3:52-56** - "Glory and praise forever!"
- **Psalm 19** - "Lord you have the words of everlasting life."
- **Psalm 107** - "Give thanks to the Lord; his love is everlasting."
- **Psalm 104** - "Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth."

2nd Reading - Romans 8:22-27 - The Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness

Gospel - John 7:37-39 - Jesus refers to the Spirit

MASS DURING THE DAY

1st Reading - Acts 2:1-11 - The Spirit comes upon the Apostles

Psalm 104 - Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth."

2nd Reading Options

- **1st Corinthians 12:3b-7,12-13** - There are different gifts, but the same Spirit
- **Romans 8:8-17** - The Spirit of God dwells in you

Gospel Options

- **John 20:19-23** - The disciples receive the Holy Spirit from Jesus
- **John 14:15-16,23b-26** - The Father will send the Holy Spirit

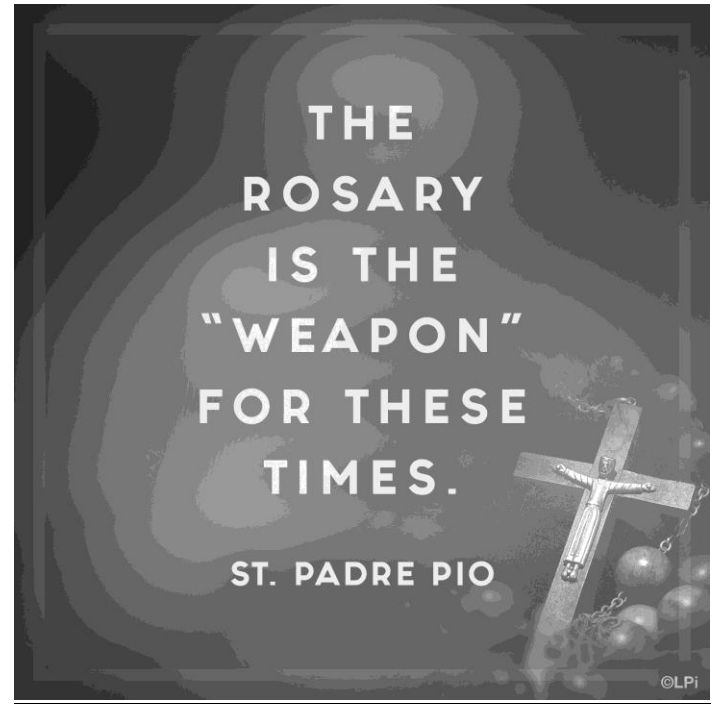
FATHER ANDREW'S 25TH PRIESTLY ANNIVERSARY
