


WEEKLY MEDITATION

Let's explore some of the themes that surface in the readings for the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity.

1st Reading - Proverbs 8:22-31

- From the beginning, God's wisdom was present and prior to all creation.
- God delights in creation, including the human race.

Psalm - 8:4-9

- "O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth!"
- God's awesome creation calls forth wonder and awe from his creatures.

2nd Reading - Romans 5:1-5

- We have peace with God through Jesus Christ, in whom we place our hope.
- We face our trials with the grace and help of the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.

Gospel - John 16:12-15

- Jesus promises his disciples that they will be given the Spirit of truth as their guide.
- The Spirit will affirm all that Jesus has said and taught.





My Dear Friends in Christ,

The National Concern Collection, which takes place on the weekend of June 18 & 19, 2022, provides funding for five Catholic initiatives that impact the faithful of Wisconsin as well as throughout the United States.

The National Retirement Fund for Religious maintains vital funding for our sisters and all religious institutes in the United States to care for their elderly and frail members now and in the future. Across the United States, hundreds of religious communities lack financial resources sufficient to meet the retirement and health-care needs of aging members.

The Catholic Campaign for Human Development, working via the Diocesan Department of Development, provides national grants that make a difference in low-income communities to fund programs addressing the very root causes of poverty. This past year \$65,000 was granted to the Wisconsin Native Loan Fund helping to provide affordable loans and financial education to our under-resourced Native American communities.

The Catholic Communication Campaign focuses on finding new ways to deliver the gospel message to people in today's digital age - on the Internet to strengthen marriage, in podcasts for daily readings, on television for Christmas Mass, and on Facebook for sharing of the faith. Fifty percent of the collection supports our local communications efforts in the Diocese.

The Archdiocese for the Military Services grants supports for ministry that provides for the spiritual, sacramental, and pastoral care of almost two million Catholics serving in the armed forces.

The Catholic University of America, located in Washington, D.C., offers students an excellent education in a faith-filled atmosphere that is grounded in the Catholic intellectual tradition.

I hope you will find it within your means to consider a contribution and donate through your collection envelope to the parish or give online.
