

- Daniel 3:52-56 "Glory and praise forever!"
- Psalm 19 "Lord you have the words of everlasting life."




FATHER ANDREW'S 25TH PRIESTLY ANNIVERSARY

School of Servant Leadership 2022-2023 **Starts This August**


