# WEEKLY MEDITATION

Here are some of the themes that we find in the Mass readings for the 3rd Sunday of Lent.

#### 1st Reading - Exodus 17:3-7

- In their thirst for water, the people grumble against Moses.
- At the Lord's command, Moses takes his staff and strikes a rock, from which water flows and the people are able to drink.

#### Psalm - 95:1-2,6-9

- "If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts."
- Unlike the Israelites who grumbled, we are exhorted to come before the Lord in joyful worship with thanksgiving.

#### 2nd Reading - Romans 5:1-2,5-8

- Having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.
- God proves his love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us.

#### Gospel - John 4:5-42

- Jesus, sitting at a well in the town of Sychar in Samaria, encounters a woman and converses with her.
- Jesus announces that he is the Christ, and the woman tells others about Jesus...and they come to believe that he is the savior of the world.

**Question for Children:** How do you experience Jesus helping and loving you?

**Question for Youth:** Jesus revealed himself to an outcast of society. How can you be "living water" to the outcasts of your school? Society? The world?

Question for Adults: When you are tempted to try to satisfy your "thirst for meaning" through some other means, what keeps you coming back to the living water of intimacy with Christ? Through what means do you experience Christ's power in your life: Sacraments? Scripture? Prayer? Others?

# SPECIAL BULLETIN ANNOUNCEMENT FROM THE DIOCESE OF SUPERIOR

After many months of research, deliberation, and prayer, Bishop James P. Powers authorized the release of the names of clergy with substantiated allegations of abuse of a minor in the Diocese of Superior. This information is available on the Diocesan website <u>www.catholicdos.org</u> and was published in the November 24, 2022 edition of the Catholic Herald. The majority of names on this list are deceased and pose no further danger. Those who are living have been removed from all priestly ministry.

Bishop Powers and his staff are aware that the publication of these names may move additional victims to come forward. The Diocese of Superior is open to receiving these calls. To make a report, please contact Coordinator of Assistance Kathy Drinkwine as shown below:

Please do not provide fresh foods (such as bread and fresh vegetables and fruits) and items requiring refrigeration, and please do not donate expired or opened items.

The majority of people we provide food and toiletry items to do not have kitchens in which to cook nor pantries to keep food. The majority are living in shelters or hotels or are homeless. We do help those with homes too, but the greater need is for unhoused people and families. <u>That said, we ask for small sized items rather than family size or economy size (e.g., big jars of peanut butter, large containers of spaghetti sauce). Individual portioned and microwavable servings are especially needed.</u>
