

Day 1 Wednesday, July 17: Depart Superior for Indianapolis

5:45 pm: Eucharistic Procession into Lucas Oil Stadium to kickoff evening activities.

7:30 pm: General Session 1 – From the Four Corners

The opening session is a powerful family reunion as we welcome Catholics from all over the country and all different backgrounds united in one, holy, Catholic, and Apostolic faith in worship of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

Day 2 Thursday, July 18: National Eucharistic Congress

"Was it not necessary that the Messiah should suffer these things and enter into his glory?' Then beginning with Moses and all the prophets, he interpreted to them what referred to him in all the scriptures." Luke 24:26 - 27

During this first full day of the Congress, participants will receive a clear kerygmatic proclamation that invites them into intimate relationship with the person of Jesus Christ. Together, we will have the opportunity to respond to this call in the celebration of the Eucharist. Then we will uncover how the story of our lives can be truly understood within the context of salvation history—the greatest love story ever told.

Day 3 Friday, July 19: National Eucharistic Congress

"Did not our hearts burn within us while he talked to us on the road?" Luke 24:31

Today, our eyes will be opened to the effects of sin and the healing that Our Lord wants to give us. On the individual level, there will be opportunities for the healing of the whole person, including physical healing, psychological wounds, and spiritual sin. On the corporate level, the Congress will recognize the areas where we've failed as a Church and the repentance and healing needed to unify the Body of Christ. As we are purified and restored, our hearts will burn with renewed zeal.

During this impactful session, we will ask the Lord for physical healing, the healing of psychological wounds, and the forgiveness of our sins—both individually and as a Body of Christ.

Day 4 Saturday, July 20: National Eucharistic Congress

"Stay with us." Luke 24:29

In the Acts of the Apostles, St. Luke recounts that the disciples "devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to the prayers" (Acts 2:42). Using the early Church as a model, this day will build up participants as disciples through Jesus Christ to live out the Gospel in their love of both God and neighbor.

Through Scriptural formation, the communion of the Body of Christ, reception of Sacramental Grace, and fervent prayer, we will be prepared and empowered to be Eucharistic missionaries.

Day 5 Sunday, July 21: National Eucharistic Congress Closing

"They set out at once." Luke 24:33

Pope Francis said the Eucharist is "a summons to go forth, as missionaries, to bring the message of the Father's tenderness, forgiveness and mercy to every man, woman and child." Throughout the history of the Church, the Holy Spirit has empowered the Church to go to the ends of the earth to share the good news. On this last day of the Congress, we will be commissioned to go out into the world as missionary disciples as we enter the third year of the National Eucharistic Revival: the Year of Mission.

This last day will commission us to go out into the world as missionary disciples to share the love of Christ in the Eucharist in our homes, schools, workplaces, parishes, and communities.

11:00 am: Closing Mass.

Depart from Indianapolis for Superior. Stops will be made on the way home for food and breaks.

All package pricing is based on a minimum of 40 paying participants per bus. If the group does not reach this number, price or programming may be adjusted. Your group leader is solely responsible for any adjustments to package pricing, itinerary, and inclusions. They act on behalf of the group to modify travel plans as needed.



Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours (PWT) reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in package price may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. By signing this enrollment form, you agree you will not initiate a chargeback against PWT for any supplier's failure to refund or provide credit due to a forced cancellation of services.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: The \$300.00 tour deposit is non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, or other costs. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on tour roster. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in package price may apply.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The Land Only package price is \$1,315.00 per person in a single room, \$920.00 per person sharing a double room, \$790.00 per person sharing a triple room, or \$725.00 per person sharing a quad room. The Land Only package does not include transportation from Superior or daily transfers from hotel to Lucas Oil Stadium. It is the traveler's responsibility to get to and from the convention center each day. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group tinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel. If you purchase any independent transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for your independently purchased transportation costs.

TRANSFERS: Round-trip transfers are included for passengers who purchase the all-inclusive package for the group tour dates.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two queen beds). Married couples may request a king bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms may be requested for \$1,215.00 per person. Quad rooms may be requested for \$1,150.00 per person. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. If a single room is confirmed, the full package price will be \$1,740.00 per person. We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you if multiple occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single room rate.

MEALS: No meals are included in the package price.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities for the coach driver(s) are included in your tour package. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: Passengers must be medically and physically fit for travel and ensure that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others. We also strongly suggest that you purchase the Cancel For Any Reason upgrade in order to cover your travel investment for unforeseen circumstances that are not covered by PWT as noted above under DISCLAIMER OF RESPONSIBILITY. PWT offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan. These benefits and services help ensure the well-being of the passenger while traveling worldwide. The insurance premium is based on total package price, including taxes, single supplements, deviation fees, late charges, etc (see chart below). If the insurance premium is included with your deposit, the passenger will be covered for pre-existing conditions.
