- We give thanks for the might and glory of God who is merciful to us.

2nd Reading - Colossians 3:1-4

- You have died with Christ, and your life is • hidden with God.
- When Christ your life appears, you will appear with him in glory.

2nd Reading - 1st Corinthians 5:6b-8

- We clear out the old yeast of malice and • wickedness.
- We make a new batch of dough with the new • yeast of sincerity and truth.

Gospel - John 20:1-9

- Mary Magdalene finds the tomb empty and runs to tell Peter and the other disciple.
- Peter and the other disciple run back to the tomb.
- They had not yet understood that Jesus had to rise from the dead.
