## WEEKLY MEDITATION

Here are some of the themes that we find in the Mass readings for the 14<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the Year.

### 1<sup>st</sup> Reading – Ezekiel 2:2-5

- The prophet is sent by God to speak to a people who are stubborn and obstinate of heart.
- Ezekiel must speak faithfully, so that whether they heed or resist, they will know that a prophet has been among them.

### Psalm – 123:1-4

- “Our eyes are fixed on the Lord, pleading for his mercy.”
- We call upon the Lord to have pity on us when we have been mocked or held in contempt by the world.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading – 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 12:7-10

- That he might not become too elated, Paul is given a “thorn in the flesh.”
- Recognizing his weaknesses, Paul discovers that with the power of Christ he becomes strong.

### Gospel – Mark 6:1-6

- Jesus arrives at his native place and the people take offense at him.
- Because of their lack of faith, the Lord does not perform any mighty deeds there.
