Gospel – Mark 8:27-35

- When asked by Jesus at Caesarea Philippi about his identity, Peter acknowledges that Jesus is the Christ.
- After the Lord speaks about his passion and death on the cross, he chastises Peter for thinking "not as God does, but as human beings do."




