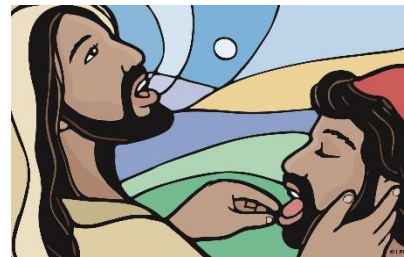
Please join us for Eucharistic Adoration the first Saturday of each month at 5:30 pm before the 6:00 pm Mass.

BIRTHDAY BLESSINGS: The first weekend of each the month a blessing will be given to every person present who has a birthday during the month.



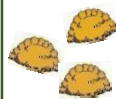
