1st Reading - Micah 5:1-4a

Psalm - 80:2-3,15-16,18-19

- "Lord, make us turn to you; let us see your face and we shall be saved."
- We call upon the Lord from heaven to come and save us so that we may have new life.

SENIOR CONGREGATE MEALS AT HOLY ASSUMPTION PARISH


