## WEEKLY MEDITATION

Let's examine some of the themes that we find in the Mass readings for the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul.

1st Reading - Acts of the Apostles 12:1-11

- During a time of great unrest James is killed and Peter is taken to prison.
- The night before his trial, an angel comes to Peter and frees him.

Psalm - 34:2-9

- "The angel of the Lord will rescue those who fear him."
- We praise God who delivers us in our need.

2nd Reading - 2nd Timothy 4:6-8, 17-18

- Paul writes how he has finished the race and kept the faith.
- He speaks about how God gave him strength and has rescued him from every evil threat.

Gospel - Matthew 16:13-19

- Peter answers the Lord's question, and Jesus gives him a new name that reveals he is the rock upon which Christ will build his church.
- This church will have the power to bind and loose, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it.

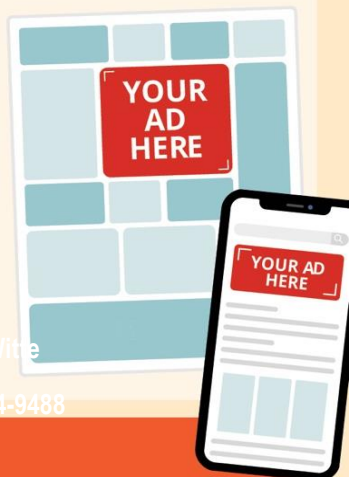
