## WEEKLY MEDITATION

### 1st Reading - Isaiah 60:1-6

### Psalms - 72:1-2,7-8,10-13

- "Lord, every nation on earth will adore you."
- God endows the king with justice and right judgment to care for the people.

### 2nd Reading - Ephesians 3:2-3a,5-6

- The Holy Spirit has revealed to the apostles and prophets that the Gentiles are coheirs of God's grace.
- As members of the same body, they are copartners in the promise of Christ.

### Gospel - Matthew 2:1-12

- The Magi, guided by a star, come to Jerusalem seeking the king of the Jews.
- They go to Bethlehem, where they encounter Jesus and present him with gold, frankincense, and myrrh.
