### **1st Reading-Jeremiah20:10-13**

### **Psalm 69:8-10,14,17,33-35**

"Lord, in your great love, answer me." The Psalmist prays for God's help in times of suffering.

### **Gospel - Matthew 10:26-33**

## SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

### **DEVOTION TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS**

So great was the Society of St. Vincent de Paul's devotion to the Sacred Heart that in 1871, Alexandre Legentil, President of the Council of Paris, wrote what became known as the "National Vow" which helped spur construction of the Basilica of Sacré-Cœur de Montmartre (Basilica of the Sacred Heart) on the highest hill in Paris. On February 5, 1872, the Society consecrated itself to the Sacred Heart, St. Marguerite-Marie's visions offer to us the twelve promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Our hearts united to His, and also to the neighbor, may we share the hope of those same promises. As St. Louise teaches, "To help you practice the love you owe your neighbor, remember when you are together that the bond of union among you is the Blood shed by the Sacred Heart of Jesus Christ."
