1st Reading - 2nd Kings 4:8-11,14-16a

Elisha is befriended by a childless couple who make a place for him to stay in their home. The prophet foretells that she will be holding her own baby in the following year.

Psalm - 89:2-3,16-19

"For ever I will sing the goodness of the Lord." The people rejoice and proclaim the blessings that they have received from God.

2nd Reading - Romans 6:3-4,8-11

Baptized into Christ Jesus, we have been baptized into his death on the Cross. Having died with Christ, we also believe that we will rise with him.

Gospel - Matthew 10:37-42

Whoever loves anything in this life more than Jesus, will lose everything. Whoever receives a disciple of Jesus, receives Jesus, and will receive a reward from the Lord.
